The Rimfire Challenge is a timed event shooting at stationary steel targets. Shooters will compete within two Divisions: Open (scopes & dot sights) and Limited (iron sights), pistol and/or rifle.

Participation is open to all safe and responsible individuals who can legally own, possess, and handle a firearm and agrees to abide by all safety regulations established by the TF&GC. The purchase of specialized, competition firearms is not required to participate in the Rimfire Challenge! Run what you have!

Rimfire Ammo/Equipment Needed:

- Ammo: 50 rounds (1 box) per gun, per stage. Typically, 200 rounds per monthly match (extra ammo is suggested).

- Magazines: Shooters must have a minimum of 2, 10 round magazines for each firearm (5 mags will help reduce wait time for each shooter).

- Gun Cases: ALL FIREARMS MUST BE IN A HARD OR SOFT CASE, UNLOADED, AT ALL TIMES. Firearms are allowed to be uncased On The Firing Line Only. Pistols cannot be holstered and rifles cannot be slung. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Safety Gear: All participants and spectators must wear eye and ear protection at designated areas.
